ITINERARY:

Depart: December 2, 2026, Dallas/ Fort Worth, TX - **Return: December 11, 2026**, Dallas/ Fort Worth, TX

Day 1, Thursday December 3rd 2026

ROB, Margibi County - Montserrado County, Monrovia

Pickup from the Robert international airport and transfer to the Maryland guest house in the sinkor area 3rd street for overnight Accommodations.

Day 2, Friday December 4th 2026

Monrovia, Montserrado County - BOMI County Demeh village

After breakfast, embark on a tour to explore the capital city of the oldest independence nation in Africa (Liberia), visiting the national Museum Of Liberia to have a detailed narrative about Liberia's unique history and culture artifact. Here u will explore a specific exhibit on Elder Paul's contribution to the national Museum, harmony clubs and project kiks contribute and partnership with the national Museum Of Liberia among others. Visit Providence Island (birth place of Liberia) centennial memorial pavilion, providence Baptist church (second oldest church in Africa where the deceleration of independence was signed) Liberia's first president (JJ Robert) house, JJ Robert Monement, ruined of the first five stars hotel in west Africa (the Ducor intercontinental hotel this is the highest point in Monrovia showing the panoramic view of the entire Monrovia city, the slump community and the Atlantic ocean, beautiful view for pictorial documentary. Visit the exterior part of the US embassy and the Masonic Temple. Visit the execution square of the 13 government officials from the William R Robert government that was executed after the military coup d'etat led by master Sargent Samuel K. Doe, drive By the executive grounds (temple of justice, executive Mansion, house of Parliament, university of Liberia, continue drive to the River restaurant at Po-river for lunch. After lunch drive 1hrs to the Demeh village BOMI County for a warm Traditional dance and masks performances including the sande and poro Dances (west Africa traditional school for boys and girls moral education), this will be a full village Life experience, (feel free at anytime to join the dances) understanding life in a village and

comparing to life in the city Drive 1hrs 20 minutes back to the hotel for overnight Accommodations at the Maryland guest house or similar.

Day 3, Saturday December 5th 2026

Monrovia - Marshall City (one of Liberia's oldest cities)

Visit history building and Churches in Marshall, including the town hall and the beautiful fishing village and understand the life of people in the village. Continue drive to the Firestone rubber plantation, understanding the role of Firestone rubber company during the civil war, and it's current operation including the processes involved in getting the latex from the tree and the demonstration to get the latex from the tree, Lunch at the Firestone restaurant, close to the Gulf field, (please notify us early if anyone is interested in playing Gulf that we will organize it) Drive back to the hotel and relax for a few hours for a combined weekend dinner at one of the exclusive Night Club bars and restaurants (D'Calabash).

Day 4, Sunday December 6

After breakfast relax in the morning hours to recover from the fatigue of night outing and dinner, later evening hours visit to the LPRC compound to see the work Elder Paul and harmony clubs is involved with. Meeting with the kids and blinds at the compound if necessary. Drive back to the hotel for overnight Accommodations at the Maryland guest house or similar, in preparation of a Long drive on Monday December 7th to Bong County.

Day 5, Monday December 7th

Monrovia - Gbarnga Bong County Cultington University College. Meet with the formal director (Albert S. Markeh) of the national Museum Of Liberia and the University leadership - Kpatawee waterfall.

After breakfast leave the hotel by 8:00 AM . Drive 3hrs to Gbarnga Bong County reception by Mr. Albert S. Market who will take us through the Cultington university Museum after that we will have an inquiry meeting with the leadership of the University asking them more about the history of the University and it role play in the life of the people of Bong County and Liberia at large. After that we will drive 30 minutes to the Famous eco-friendly Kpatwee waterfall. Feel free to swim in the waterfall, games are available, (volleyball, ludo, Pool and many more) Breakfast at the

Kpatwee waterfall. Drive back to Monrovia for overnight Accommodations at the Maryland guest house or similar.

Day 6, Tuesday December 8th 2026

Monrovia - Grand Bassa - Edina City back to Monrovia.

After breakfast by 10 Am drive historical Buchanan city (a city named after Thomas Buchanan from the USA) grand Bassa county exploring the touristic beauty of Buchanan city a home away from home blessed with great people of hospitality, including it Historical sites beautiful Sunset Beach and later take a motorized boat to a historical trading point in 1820s and 1830s formally established in 1833 with a lots of historic monuments, buildings and Churches from the African Americans in the 1800s. Back to Monrovia for overnight Accommodations at the Maryland guest house or similar.

Day 7, Wednesday December 9, 2026

Monrovia - Libassa eco-lodge Marshal City. Beach day and farewell Dining.

After breakfast leave the hotel by 11, AM to the Libassa ecologe for breakfast and pool farewell party. Drive back to the Maryland guest house for relaxation in preparation for a farewell dinner at the Royal Grand hotel. Drive back to the hotel for overnight accommodations.

Day 8, Thursday December 10, 2026

Visit to souvenir shop and market.

Leave the hotel 9 AM after breakfast to the souvenir shop and waterside market in Monrovia. Drive back to the hotel at 1 PM to relax for a night flight schedule 8:30 PM

We leave the hotel 4:30 PM to be at the airport for check-in 2 hours before flight departure.
