Brief Story of LCCC:

Liberia Christian Community College (LCCC), also known as "Kpawee," is located in the Shoes Factory along the Somalia Drive in the Township of Gardnersville.

LCCC was founded in 1984 by a group of Liberian Christians.

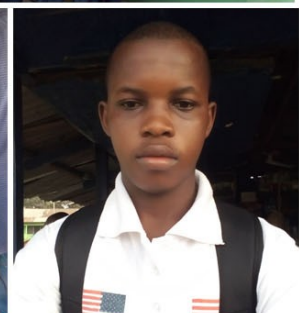
Liberia Christian Community College (LCCC) has a standard of primary and secondary school education running two (2) school sessions - morning and night schools. The current enrollment for Academic 2016/2017 school year is 1,200 students - boys and girls. The head and principal of the school is Bishop Nicodimus Solomon, having a total staff and teachers of 62 persons.

LCCC runs an Advance Teaching Education Project

for teachers thru the Ministry of Education. The project is called Standard Teacher Training Institute (STTI). After two (2) years of teacher training courses, STTI offers a "C" certificate to certify the successful teachers.

On February 9th 2016, LCCC was gutted by fire, burning the front view of the school. A group of hooligans threw a petrol bomb on the school building, destroying the school pharmacy, Project KIKS Liberia 500 gallons Poly Tank and structure, two (2) classrooms and other important and valuable things.

After a year, on February 7th 2017, Project KIKS Liberia restored and reinstalled its 500 gallon Poly Tank and structure, reviving the clean water campaign for the Bulk Water Initiative for Schools project institutionalized by Project KIKS Liberia.
