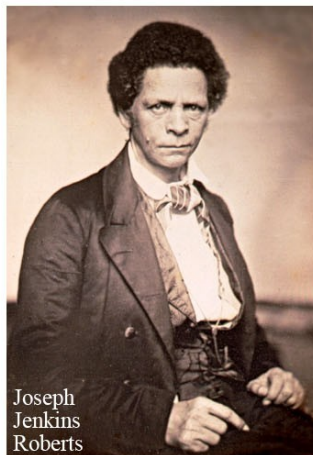

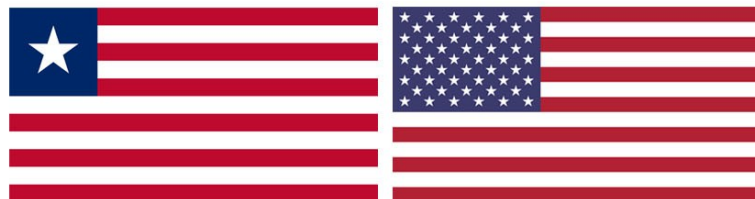

Liberia is a country located along the Ivory Coast of West Africa. In 1821, Liberia was founded, established, colonized, and controlled by freed slaves, citizens of the United States of America. A constitution modeled after the US Constitution was adopted. The Commonwealth of Liberia declared its independence from the US American Colonization Society on July 26, 1847. In 1848, Joseph Jenkins Roberts, an Black American from Virginia was elected the first President of Liberia. In celebration of the day, Project KIKS will host a party for the Institute of the Blind and children survivors of the Ebola Virus, at our compound in Monrovia, Liberia.
