Martin Martinez guides the youth away from drugs, gangs and other addictions by means of sports. The youth are involved with an organization Pentathlon Deportivo Militarizado Universitario (University Militarized Sports Pentathlon) or PDMU. SPORTS such as soccer, basketball, volleyball, karate, wrestling, gymnasium, color guard and much more. Not only do they participate in several activities but they also partake in Humanist education to make learners useful members for themselves and for other members of society.

PDMU is a youth sports organization created in Mexico in 1938 by Gustavo Bay Prada a little bit before he was elected as director of University Of Mexico, it pursues the greatness of the country by training Mexican boys and girls. Their Motto is PATRIA, HONOR Y FUERZA (COUNTRY, HONOR, AND STRENGTH).

During the pandemic since no sports are allowed for safety reasons, the young men and women in Durango are helping their local communities by distributing essential care packages, provided by donations.

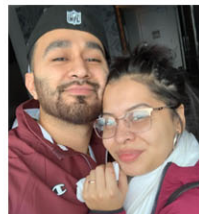
Pictures below are part of PDMU organization members distributing essential care packages to families struggling during Covid-19 along with a picture of competition before Covid Pandemic.
